



Before Usage

1. Read Your Manual
2. P.P.E. (Personal Protection Equipment)
3. Know Your Trigger
4. Only Use Air Compressors
5. Use Proper Tool for the Job

During Use

1. Don't Point the Tool In Unsafe Directions
2. Keep Finger off the Trigger
3. Clean, Safe Work Area and Positioning
4. Report Any Injuries or Malfunctions
5. Always Unplug Tools When Not in Use
6. Never Modify the Tool

Common Causes of Injuries

- Lack of Training
- Improper Work Procedures
- Negligence
- Lack Of Maintenance or Improper Maintenance
- Nail Ricochet
- Horseplay
- Modifying The Tools to Bypass Safety Features
- Using High-Pressure Power Sources
